

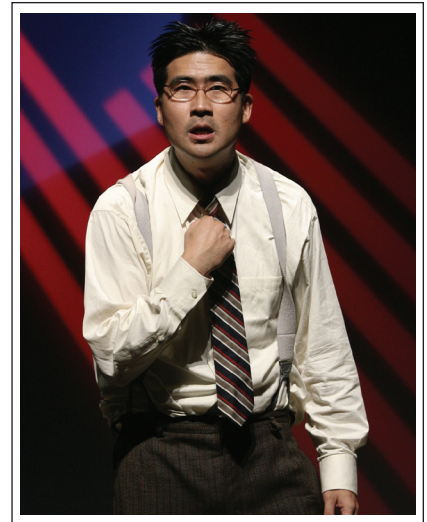
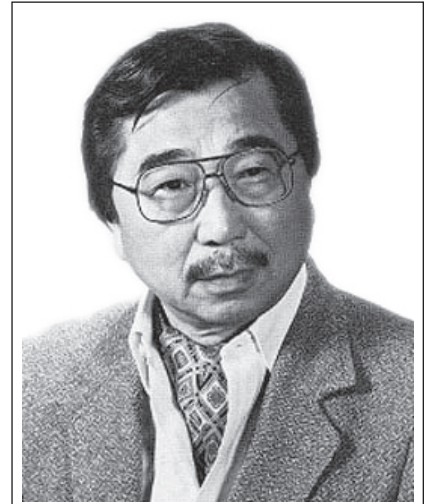
NORTHERN CALIFORNIA TIME OF REMEMBRANCE
